

SPIRITUAL READING'S BOOTH-

A spiritual reading's booth is where we minister to our campus by solely relying on the presence of God through the gifts of the Spirit, limiting ourselves to God's voice and expecting God to show up and lives to be changed.

-START WITH PRAYER-

Declare what the Lord is doing, ask God to highlight the needs to go after, how God views your campus?

IMPORTANT: when other team members show up to help minister after your prayer time, pull them aside, and give them vision for the outreach, and pray with them.

-Ministering in the Gifts of the Spirit -

Every believer has the ability to tap into God's thoughts toward any individual and any given time because we have been given the mind of Christ (1 Corinthians 2:16). Operating in the gifts are a way to share God's love to the campus, God can use these gifts as well as others in a multitude of ways to show His power and wonder!

Prophesying

1Corin. 14:3- 3But everyone who prophesies speaks to men for their strengthening, encouragement and comfort

When we go out and prophesy over people's life, we are sharing what God has already spoken in His word about them.

Words of Knowledge

"A divine revelation from God telling or showing what is happening now or what has happened"

Jesus tells the Samaritan woman about her life, and it cause here to repent. (John 4:16-26)

(I.e. I feel a sharp pain, The Holy Spirit could be highlighting that the individual needs healing in that area of pain)

Discerning of Spirits

"A divine ability to see or discern: when the Holy Spirit is moving, the presence of angelic or demonic activity, or the ability to see into the intentions of the hearts" (1 Corinthians 12:10)

Book of Acts, a small girl is following Paul and Silas claiming to give God praise for their visit to her city, Paul discerned her words were inspired by a demonic force. (Act 16: 16-18)

-Conducting The Booth-

- 1. Greeting**
- 2. Share Purpose:** *"Just so you know we are not palm readers or physics, we are Christians. We believe that God wants to speak to everyone on our campus, and specifically with you today. You can expect to walk away encouraged. Is that ok?"*
- 3. Transition:** *Is there a particular reason you came to the booth?*
- 4. Move into prayer:** *Do they have a prayer request?*
- 5. Wait on the Lord:** Ask the Lord to speak to you specifically about what their request. Also, ask the Lord for a word of knowledge or prophetic word for the person.
- 6. Invitation for Christ:** *Always gives this opportunity! Ask: "Is there any reason why you wouldn't make Jesus Christ*

Check List

- *Setting up Canapé & walls (Do you have four people for each side?)
- *Putting up SRB sign
- * Tables and chairs (Do all tables have chairs for 3 people? Make sure the space is not cluttered!)
