## -START WITH PRAYER-

Declare what the Lord is doing, ask God to highlight the needs to go after, how God views your campus? **IMPORTANT: when other team members show up to help minister after your prayer time, pull them aside, and give them vision for the outreach, and pray with them.**

### *Approaching Your Person*

1. **Always have smile:** it goes along way 😊
2. **Be Honest:** “Hi my name is Jamil, my friend and I were praying and asking God to highlight someone in this (quad, hall, gym, etc) that he wanted to encourage today, and we believe you are that person.
3. **Share with them your description you have**
4. **Always ask in question form:**  
“Is there anyone in you know who may has cancer? (wait for response) We know that God wants to heal them”
5. **Pray with them:** Pray for the exact need that God shares with you to pray them about, and be open!
6. **Invitation for Christ:** always give an opportunity for them to make Jesus as their Lord and Savior. "Is there any reason why you wouldn't make Jesus Christ the Lord of your life today?"
